Seoul Family Court helps out foreigners staying in Korea who married Korean and are having difficulties dealing with divorce.

1. We introduce the designated attorneys of litigation aid for foreigners to the following persons.

- Foreigners or immigrants staying in Korea who cannot fluently speak Korean
- Those who are not subject to lose their case
- Those who are at low ability to fund the fees for the attorneys

2. The designated attorney of litigation aid for foreigners will give aids as follows.

- Counseling about the application of litigation aid and decision of whether to file a lawsuit or not
- Preparing and filing the application form of litigation aid and petition
- Supplementation due to the court's advice or order to supplement regarding the application form of litigation aid or petition
- All works necessary for the litigation act in the case that the decision to give aid was made as to all the attorney fees

3. To what extent can I get litigation aid?

- Revenue stamp (petition, written appeal, others)
- Attorney fees
- Others (ex) interpretation, translation, etc.)
- All litigation fees including the above items

4. You can also get help through the process aid regarding the non-litigation cases.

Those who do not have ability to pay the fees required in the process of family non-litigation cases or those who have significant encumbrances in their life due to the concerned expenses will get help from the designated attorneys with the application of revenue stamp, transmittal payment, attorney fee, appraisal fee, etc. or help you by the decision of the court's authority.
